



I-3 to I-4 migration update: AORE date confirmed

Dear Inmarsat Partner and Customer

We are writing to advise you that the migration of **Classic Aero, Fleet 77, Swift 64 and Inmarsat C services** (to include Aero C and Mini C) from the Atlantic Ocean Region East (AORE)* I-3 F2 satellite to the I-3 F5 satellite has been scheduled to take place on **30 October 2018 at 11:00 UTC**.

* Note that AORE is part of the overall I-3 to I-4 migration programme but it is not moving to the I-4 constellation.

As you will appreciate, our primary objective is to ensure that the migration process is as smooth as possible with minimum disruption caused to our customers and partners.
