

# I-3 to I-4 migration dates: AORE reminder and IOR confirmed

23 October 2018

Dear Inmarsat Partner and Customer

We are writing to remind you that the migration of Classic Aero, Fleet 77, Swift 64 and Inmarsat C services (to include Aero C and Mini C) from the Atlantic Ocean Region East (**AORE**)\* I-3 F2 satellite to the I-3 F5 satellite is taking place on **30 October 2018 at 11:00 UTC**.

\* Note that AORE is part of the overall I-3 to I-4 migration programme but it is not migrating to the I-4 constellation; AORE will remain in the I-3 constellation.

We would also like to advise you that the final migration of all services from the Indian Ocean Region (**IOR**) I-3 to the Europe/Middle East/Asia (EMEA) I-4 has been scheduled to take place on **12 December 2018 at 12:00 UTC** (subject to change for operational reasons).

As you will appreciate, our primary objective is to ensure that the migration process is as smooth as possible with minimum disruption caused to our customers and partners.
